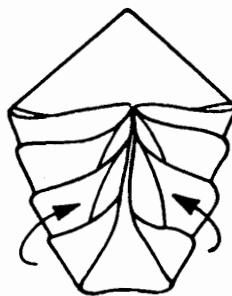
1. Fold napkin in fourths.



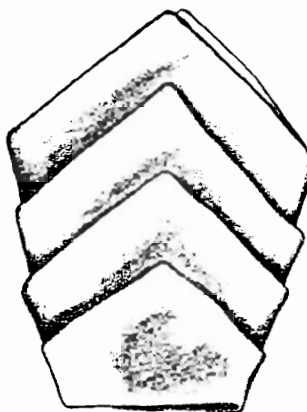
2. Fold up top flap.



3. Fold up each of remaining flaps, leaving 1" between points.



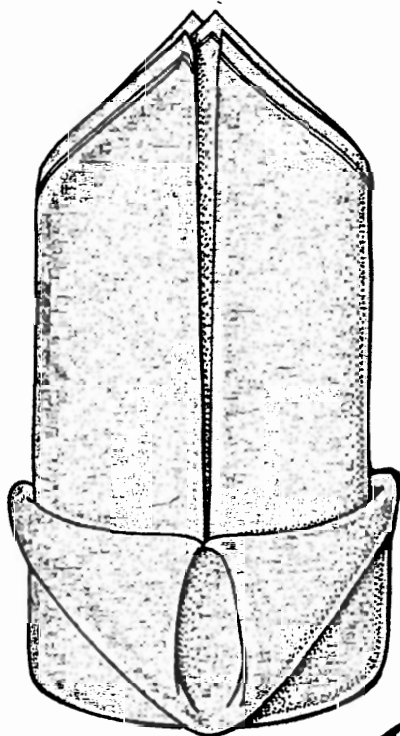
4. Turn napkin over and fold in sides.



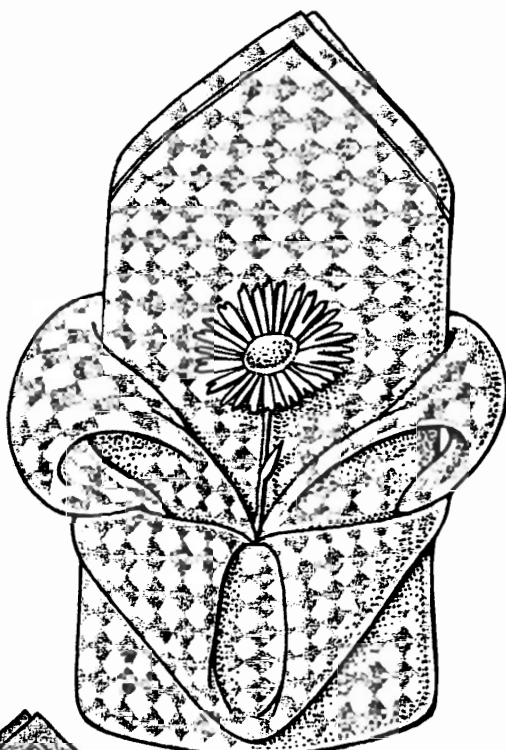
5. Turn napkin over and lay flat.

Bishop's Hat

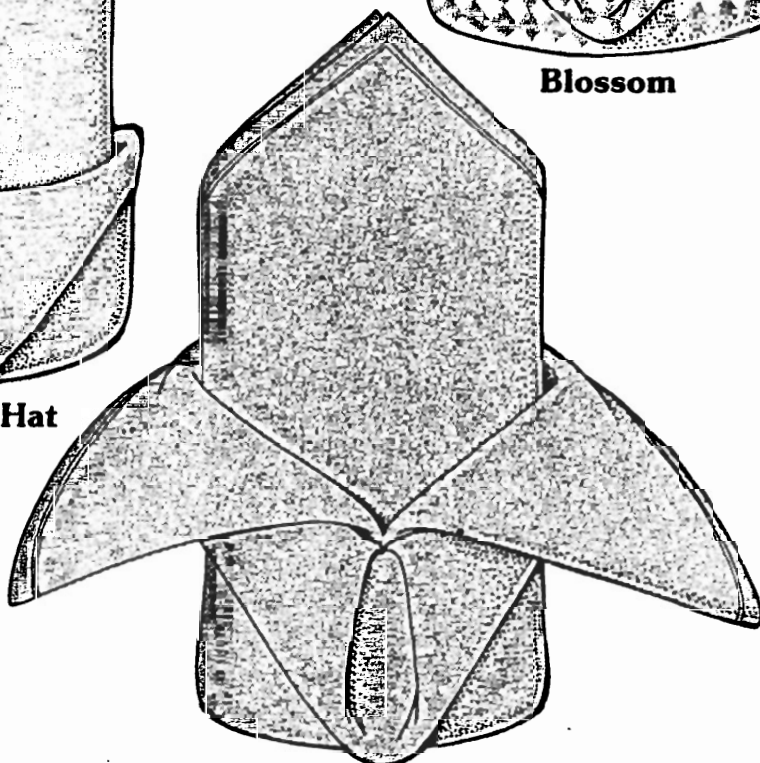
The Bishop's Hat is a traditional fold that has graced tables all over the world. With the front sides of the hat pulled down, the shape can be made to resemble a Butterfly, and with the sides pulled down and tucked into the fold, it looks like a Blossom.



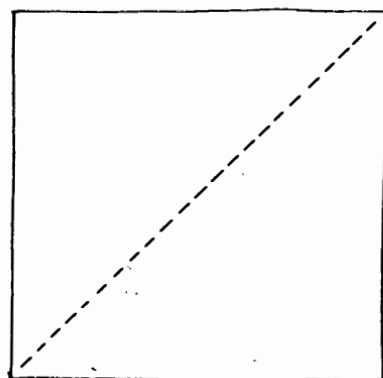

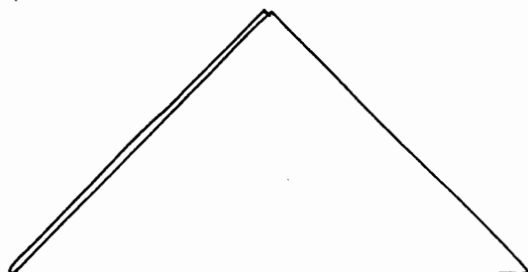
Blossom

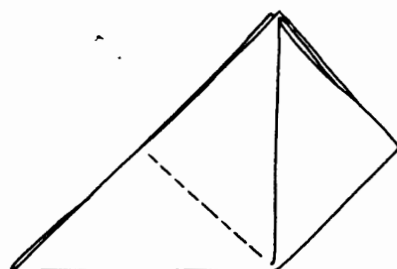

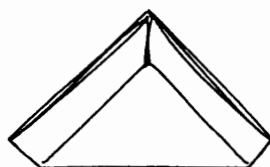

★★★ Instructions

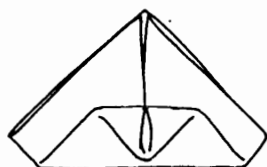
1. Fold the napkin in half diagonally to form a triangle.
2. Place the fold along the bottom edge.
3. Hold your finger at the center of the bottom edge as you fold the right and left corners up to the top corner.
4. Fold up the bottom point to within one inch of the top point.
5. Fold the same point back to the bottom edge.
6. Turn the napkin over and fold the left side toward the center.
7. Fold the right side over the left side, tucking the point into the left fold. Stand the napkin up.

Butterfly Variation

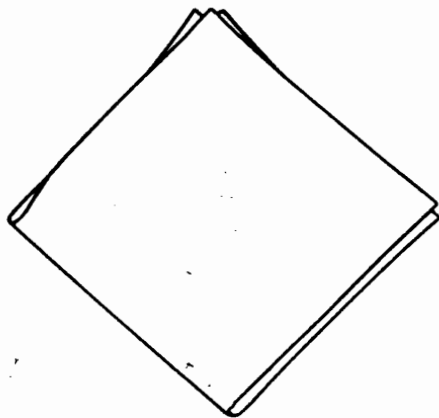
Butterfly variation: Pull down the left and right sides of the Bishop's Hat until they are horizontal.



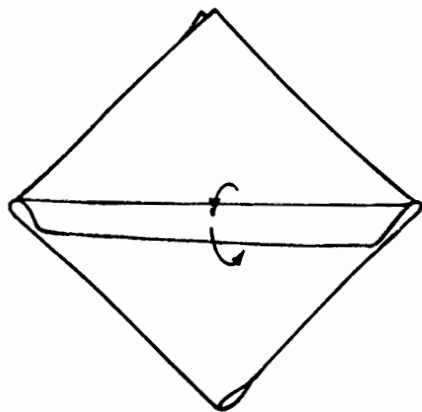
Blossom Variation

Blossom variation: Turn down the right and left sides and tuck the points into the fold.

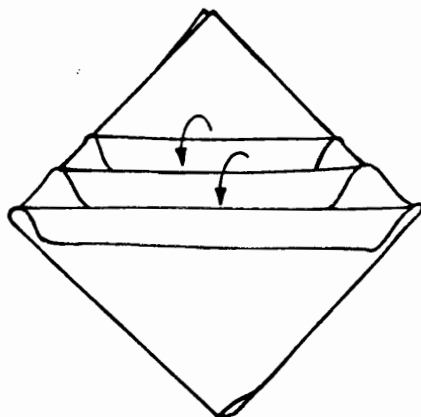

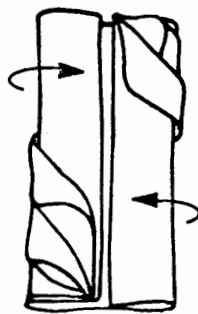
1. Fold napkin in fourths.

3. Tuck in second and third flaps.



4. Turn napkin over and fold in sides.



5. Turn napkin over and lay flat.

Note: A flower or card can be tucked inside one of the flaps.
