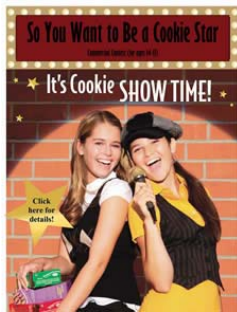
## **Be a Part of the 2008 Girl Scout Leadership Institute**
