Timeline:

4. Distribute nomination certificate and design to Mountain Magic Planning Committee for feedback.

At least one week before Camper Weekend

1. Make 40-50 copies of camper recognition certificate on good quality paper, i.e., cotton fiber or parchment.
2. Buy calligraphy pen, or use pen from previous year.
3. Make 30 copies of nomination form, fitting two or three nomination forms onto one piece of paper, and cutting them up.
4. Distribute camper nomination forms either in packets or in a central location at camp.
5. Label two containers (cardboard box or large empty plastic jar) as Nomination forms.
6. Find a poster board or whiteboard to post names of nominees.
7. (Optional) Collect small gifts to awardees. For several years, we have given nominees a combination keychain, whistle, flashlight, compass imprinted with Mountain Magic that we purchased several years ago for \$1 apiece. We have a year or two of those left.

During Camper Weekend:

1. Place collection receptacles for nomination forms near fireplace.
2. At every meal, check the collection jar for nominations.
3. Post the names of the honorees in a place where folks can see it. Notify honorees that they should contact committee chair at mealtimes to collect their certificate and/or prize.
3. Using a calligraphy pen, write the name of the nominee on the recognition certificate.
4. Distribute recognition certificates/prizes at meals.

Supplies needed.

1. Copies of camper recognition nomination forms. (Copies to be donated by committee member family employer)
2. Good quality paper for certificates (\$15, if previous year's paper is gone)
3. Calligraphy pen (\$10 if previous year's pen is gone)
4. Bucket for collecting nominations (No cost, use recycled materials)
5. Poster or white board for nominations. (\$2 or scrounged materials)
