Committee Description: Collect/create door prizes for campers

Committee Description: To add some fun to the Mountain Magic Leader Weekend, provide nominal gifts to campers for their contributions to Girl Scouting. Committee members should collect or create gifts.

Volunteers needed: One.

Timeline: During the year before Camper Weekend

- 1. Solicit committee members, others, to donate "white elephant" gifts to Door Prize Committee.
- 2. Obtain a receptacle (large cardboard box or bag) to store camper recognition gifts during weekend.

During Camper Weekend:

- 1. Obtain a copy of names of all campers.
- 2. Cut names into strips and place in receptacle, to be drawn at random for prizes.
- 3. Find a location in the dining hall in which to store receptacle for camper gifts. Location must be convenient to the dining hall, but gifts should not seem as though they were up for grabs.
- 4. At every meal, draw a number of names for door prizes.
- 5. Post a list of door prize winners names in a place where folks can see it. Notify winners that they should contact committee chair at mealtimes to collect their prize.
- 6. Distribute door prizes at meals. Allow winners to select their prize from available, unwrapped prizing, thus saving wasted paper and insuring that campers get a prize that they want.
- 7. At final meal, openly distribute remaining prizes to anyone who wants one, to distribute all prizes.

Supplies needed.

- 1. Prizes (Could use a small budget to use for picking up prizes at yard sales)
- 2. Container for storing door prizes. (No cost, use recycled materials)
- 3. Poster or white board for prize winners. (\$2 or scrounged materials)
